



10 ways to virtually acknowledge and thank your volunteers and celebrate during National Volunteer Week 2022

1. Take part in our [#ColourYourCommunityRed online campaign](#)
2. Give a shout-out to your volunteers on social media. Highlight individuals, teams and projects that have helped further your organisations' mission. Don't forget to use the following hashtags #NVW2022 #ColourYourCommunityRed #SAvolunteer #VolunteeringNT
3. Email or post personalised thank you notes that highlight the impact of individual volunteer contributions.
4. Find out your volunteers' language of recognition so you can plan meaningful activities throughout the year.
5. Set up virtual meetings with your volunteers to celebrate all they have done for your organisation –talk about their volunteering experiences and the positive impact they make on your organisation.
6. Gather thank you messages from other staff members and pass them on to the volunteers who have made a difference in their lives.
7. Nominate a superstar volunteer for a local or national award to formally recognise their efforts.
8. Send your volunteers a special [National Volunteer Week certificate](#) or a [merchandise](#) gift.
9. Ask volunteers to share stories about their fellow volunteers. Are they constantly impressed by someone's positive attitude? Have they seen a fellow volunteer diffuse a challenging situation? Share it on socials.
10. Start a private group on social media and invite volunteers, staff and community members to join. Set a time to gather for a virtual party and share videos, images and stories on socials about the impact volunteers have had.
